You May Unite With the Church . . .

It is the responsibility of the elders to examine and receive new members. Prior to the membership interview, they will meet with you to review the contents of *The Presbyterian Church in America: A Manual for New Members* and the following membership promises.

. . .by Profession of Faith and Baptism

1. Do you acknowledge yourself to be a sinner in God's sight, justly deserving His displeasure, and without hope, except through His sovereign mercy?
2. Do you believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of God and Savior of sinners, and do you receive and rest upon Him alone for salvation as He is offered in the Gospel?
3. Do you now resolve and promise, in humble reliance upon the grace of the Holy Spirit, to endeavor to live as becomes the followers of Christ?
4. To the best of your ability, do you promise to support the Church in its worship and work?
5. Do you submit to the government and discipline of the Church, and do you promise to study its purity and peace?

. . .by Letter or Certificate of Transfer

If you are already a member of a church, and have previously been baptized, you may either give the Clerk of Session (Ron Heald) the contact information for your previous church, or you may contact them yourself and let them know that you are in the process of joining WSCCC. We need to obtain from them a transfer letter or certificate of membership. The letter/certificate should say that you are a member in good standing, and that they are releasing you to WSCCC's spiritual care.

. . .by Reaffirmation of Faith

If you cannot obtain a letter or certificate of transfer from your previous church, but want to make a new beginning and reaffirm your commitment to Jesus Christ, you may be received on your own statement of faith. Whether you are received by profession of faith, certificate of transfer, or you are reaffirming your faith, the session will ask you to take the vows listed above.
